	Sculpture	an artistic form in which materials are worked into three-dimensional art objects.	
	Assemble	to come or bring together; collect or congregate. to fit or join together	
	Transient Art	is non-permanent, constantly evolving and process orientated creativity.	
	Structure	something built or arranged in a definite way.	
	Texture	how something feels when it is touched,	
	Impress	is to indent a design or textures into soft clay by pressing different shaped objects into it.

	Slip	Slip is made by mixing clay with water . Slip is a fine, liquid form of clay used with scoring to cement together parts that have been formed separately.	
	Proportion	refers to the relative size of parts of a whole (elements within an object).	
	Ornate	Elaborately, even excessively ornamental.	
	Repetition	it is a recurrence of a particular line, pattern, shape, or other visual elements in a single or part of the series.

	Sequence	the order that something happens or exists in, or the order it is supposed to happen.	
	Surface Texture	In the visual arts , texture is the perceived surface quality of a work of art . It is an element of two-dimensional and three-dimensional designs and is distinguished by its perceived visual and physical properties.	
	Scale	refers to the size of an object (a whole) in relationship to another object (another whole). In art the size relationship between an object and the human body is significant. In experiencing the scale of an artwork we tend to compare its size to the size of our own bodies	
	Surface	is the uppermost layer of a thing. In the context of art , the surface determines how a colour is reflected, absorbed or scattered, depending upon its texture.	
	Relief	is a sculptural technique where the sculpted elements remain attached to a solid background of the same material. To create a sculpture in relief is to give the impression that the sculpted material has been raised above the background plane
