#### MORNING

Entry via Manning Road gate into the KS2 playground or Abbey Road gate onto the KS1 playground. Parent/carers leave via the car park gate.

#### AFTERNOON

Access for all main school parents/carers via the car park gate and exit via the appropriate playground gate – KS2 onto Manning Road and Reception & KS1 onto Abbey Road.

There will be members of the Senior Leadership team on the playgrounds to direct you.

  - To wear a mask if you are able


