#### **DANGEROUS DRIVING**



A number of parents/carers have raised concerns about dangerous driving around the school at drop off and pick up times. We have sought advice from Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership and whilst Road Safety Officers do not have any policing powers to use in cases of driving without due care or attention, they have provided us with details of the Lincolnshire Police on-line reporting facility for members of the public to report driving offences. ### **DROP OFF AND COLLECTION ROUTINES**

We have noticed a relaxation of caution at both drop off and collection times and would like to remind you that our morning and afternoon arrangements remain the same at the present time and when we return in Term 6.

- You should continue to abide by the one-way system in operation
- Children must remain with parents/carers while waiting on school grounds please don't let them run around
  - You should not congregate in groups, either whilst waiting for or after collecting your child/ren.
  - You should be considerate to other pedestrians when waiting on the footpaths around school
