## FRIENDSHIP WEEK

We are pleased to inform you that week commencing  $16^{\text{th}}$  November will be our 'Friendship' week.

The theme is 'United Against Bullying.' This links to this year's national Anti-Bullying week which aims to highlight the fact that we all need to come together and play our part to unite against bullying.
