## COVID WINTER GRANT SCHEME - GROCERY PACKS

In order to protect vulnerable households during the pandemic the £170m Government COVID Winter Grant Scheme is being made available to Local Authorities to support those most in need with the cost of food, energy (heating, cooking, lighting), water bills and other essentials.

As part of the support it is providing, Lincolnshire County Council has chosen to make a contribution to support families with providing food during the Christmas period. A £35 grant will be allocated to Early Years settings for the following children:

- Those accessing their 2 year old entitlement
- 3 & 4 year olds in receipt of Early Years Pupil Premium

Your child has been identified within one of the above eligible categories to receive this grant. Settings must use the grant to provide families with support for meals for children during the Christmas holidays.
