Dear Parents/Carers,

Our aim is to make the timings of the school day as 'normal' as possible, not only for the children, but also to support Parents and Carers. This is also why we will be opening our Kids' Club provision before and after school from September 2nd. We feel confident that our plans mean that we do not need a reduced timetable or part days. We have though made provision for a slightly later start for our Reception pupils to aid their transition for Term 1 at Bourne Abbey.

Please can I reassure you that our COVID-19 risk assessment will remain 'live' throughout the summer holiday and from September 1st. We will continue to act swiftly to any Government and Public Health England guidance and directives. If any of our plans need to change during the summer, I will be in contact via ParentMail, the school website and Facebook to keep you fully informed.

As you will see in the FAQs document, we will be offering our usual ambitious, creative and broad curriculum in all subjects from the start of the Autumn term. We will of course plan on the basis of the educational needs of our children and address any gaps in their knowledge and skills. We will maintain our high expectations and aspirational targets for all our children. Intervention, provision and 'catch up' will be in place for the core areas of the curriculum. We absolutely understand that many of our children may experience a variety of emotions in response to Coronavirus and returning to school. Our Mental Health and Wellbeing First Aiders will be available to work with the children. All our staff will provide plenty of pastoral support to all the children, including rebuilding friendships and addressing and responding to issues linked to Covid-19.

We hope that our FAQs document answers the questions and concerns you may have. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any further questions. We are still navigating through unchartered Coronavirus territory and welcome any thoughts and advice you may have.

I would like to take this opportunity to say what a privilege it continues to be for me to be your Executive Headteacher. There have been many challenges and successes this year especially! It has not always been easy and I have learnt so much.
