We will shortly be beginning some work in Year 4 about 'Growing and Changing' as part of our RSE catch up. This work forms part of an ongoing programme of Relationships and Sex Education (RSE), which we deliver throughout the school. We encourage you to discuss any of these areas with your children before, during or after our topic, as children greatly value being able to talk to their parents/carers about these issues. We have carefully reviewed the resources we use to support our teaching of Growing and Changing, to ensure they are appropriate to the age and needs of the children.
