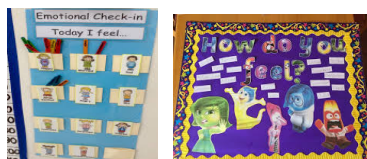
Below is a menu of ideas that you and your child might like to take part in. You can be as creative and as practical as you wish,

Communication and Language

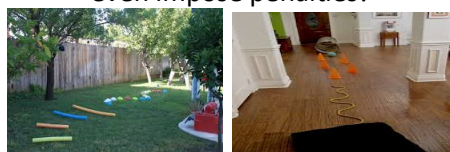
Once upon a time there lived a Can you think of the next part to the story?

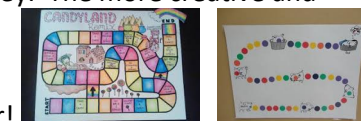


Mathematics
