Details of the competitions are below:

Age Groups:

- Junior 7 to 10 years
- Intermediate 11 to 13 years
- Senior 14 to 17 years of age (by 31 August 2021)

Prizes:

In each age group of the competitions the winner will receive £50, the runner up £25 and there will be Highly Commended certificates.

Deadline:

The deadline for submissions is 31st October

Categories

- **Young Writer:** the subject is 'The Environment' with a limit of 550 words. Entries can be handwritten, typed or word processed, and lodged in paper form. Prose or poetry, the choice is yours. No entries can be returned and the Rotary Club of Bourne has the right to reproduce or publish any of the entries. - **Young Artist:** the subject is 'Colours of Nature'. Entries can be in any medium up to A2, including ceramics, but not photographs. Your art entry should be sent or delivered to Rotarian John Megson at 18 Galletly Close, Bourne PE10 9BA
- **Young Photographer:** the subject is 'Colours of Nature'. Entries should be digital in a portfolio of no more than three, to johnmegson@hotmail.com.

Registration is not necessary, and entries must be accompanied by your full name and address, date of birth, your school and if available your email address. The Rotary Club of Bourne has the right to reproduce or publish any of the entries.
