Details of the competitions are below:

### Age Groups:

- Junior up to and including 10 years
- Intermediate 11 to 13 years
- Senior 14 to 17 years of age (by 31 August 2022)

### Prizes:

In each age group of the competitions the winner will receive £50, the runner up £25 and there will be Highly Commended certificates.

### Deadline:

The deadline for submissions is Friday 25<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

### Categories

**Young Writer:** Produce a written or typed story in prose entitled '**Peace**'. This could be fiction or non-fiction, prose, or a poem, as long as the piece relates to the theme of Peace. No more than 550 words for prose entries, no more than 40 lines for poetry. No pictures or drawings please & all entries must be legible. **Young Artist:** Produce one 2 dimensional, up to a maximum A2 size, unframed, piece of artwork based on the theme '**Sunrise & Sunset**'. Entries may be in pen & ink, paint, collage or printmaking, but not photographs. Each entrant must provide a brief sentence describing the relationship of the artwork to the theme. **Young Photographer:** Produce one photograph based upon the theme '**The Beauty of Architecture**'. The photo must be submitted in a digital format & be at least 1500 pixel in size on the longest length. Mobile phones may be used in addition to cameras. Each entrant must provide a brief sentence describing the relationship of the photograph to the theme.
