## **SWITCH OFF FORTNIGHT 14.11.22-25.11.22**

Our Eco Warriors have been busy with our 'Switch Off Fortnight' campaign as part of our Eco Schools work, focussing on the small actions we can all take to save energy.

During Switch Off Fortnight, our Eco Warriors have been undercover in their own classroom and completed an energy audit to find out just how many appliances and lights are left on during lunchtime. Our Eco Warriors have also led a Collective Worship for the whole school to help raise awareness of our 'Switch Off Fortnight' campaign. This included sharing top tips of how we can save energy and money both in school and at home.

During this time, children are taking part in lessons led by their teachers, focussing on saving energy. We hope the children are sharing their learning with you at home.
