Details of the competitions are below:

## Age Groups:

- Junior 5 to 10 years old
- Intermediate 11 to 13 years old
- Senior 14 to 17 years old

Entrants must not have been over the upper age limit for each group on 31st August 2023. This means that some junior entrants may be 11, intermediate entrants may be 14 & some senior entrants may be 18 by the time some of the later stages of the competition take place.

## Prizes:

In each age group of the competitions the winner will receive £50, the runner up £25 and there will be Highly Commended certificates.

The deadline for submissions is Friday 24th November 2023.

Young Writer: Produce a written or typed story in prose entitled 'Rebuilding'. This could be fiction or non-fiction, prose, or a poem, as long as the piece relates to the theme of Rebuilding. No more than 550 words for prose entries, no more than 40 lines for poetry. No pictures or drawings please & all entries must be legible.

**Young Artist**: Produce one 2 dimensional, up to a maximum A2 size, unframed, piece of artwork based on the theme '**Rebuilding'**.
