In Maths, we will be continuing to develop our speedy recall of our times tables. We'll consolidate our 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables. We're also going to be learning different methods of division, consolidating our ability to use the inverse. We will be learning how to multiply and divide 2 digit numbers, both mentally and using formal written methods.

During our measurement learning, we will use practical activities to help us to measure the perimeter and length of objects and shapes. We will use Math Talk to develop our reasoning

skills.
