SCHOOL TRANSPORT SEPTEMBER 2024



If your child is starting primary school or transferring to secondary school in September 2024 they may be eligible for school transport. If you think your child is eligible please apply for transport as soon as you have your offer of a school place (1st March for secondary school or 16th April for primary). Early transport applications are encouraged to ensure that transport is in place in time for the start of the September term.
