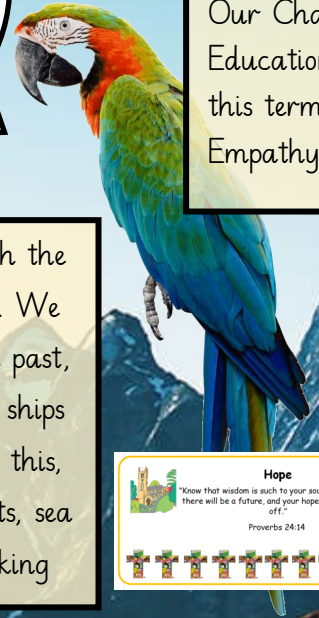
It's a pirate's life for me!

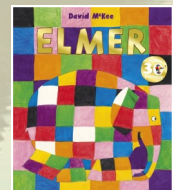
Our Christian Values
