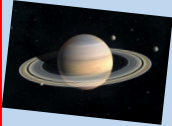

# Term 6 To infinity and beyond

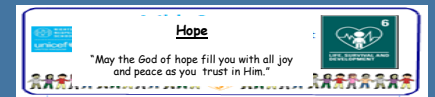
### Each Week
