


Dear Parents/Carers,

P.E.

School Visits

This year, our school visit will have a Science focus and will be in the summer term. Further details to follow soon!

In History, the children will learn about why and how the Normans first built castles in England. They will research the types of people who lived in castles and what life would have been like for them. We will analyse different sources and think about what we can learn from these. We will study Lincoln Castle and learn about why it is important to our local area. We will also have a 'Raymond Mays Day', learning about a famous racing car driver from Bourne, and how cars have changed over time. We will think about the impact Raymond Mays had on our local area.

We encourage the children to read as much as possible both in school and at home. We use the Pawsome Gang Reading Dogs to discuss different reading skills. They should try to read at least 3 times a week (it doesn't have to be a whole book each time!) and can choose either their school books or a book that interests them at home. Please record their reading with you in the reading diary. After 3 entries a week, they will be entered into the Reading Raffle for a chance to win a book! Our usual palette of choice homework has been sent out with a range of cross curricular activities to choose from. As the children begin to learn their times tables this year, Times Table Rockstars is an excellent way of practising them at home. Login details will be sent out again soon. Numbots has a range of mathematical skills to practise and Hit the Button is great for 'beat the

clock' games!
