MORNING ROUTINES



Please may we remind you about our safeguarding routines for morning drop off:

Gates are opened at 8.45 a.m. and closed at 9.00 a.m. A member of staff will stand at both the Abbey Road and Manning Road gates



Parents/carers of Reception & KS1 pupils must walk their child to their classroom and ensure that they enter the building and are handed over to an adult



Pupils in KS2 may enter the playground unaccompanied at 8.45 a.m. However, please note that all children should be escorted to the gate by an adult who should wait with them **until the gates are opened by a member of staff**
