As well as all our preparation for SATs, our topic this term will involve us discovering all about what rainforests are be able to locate them on maps.

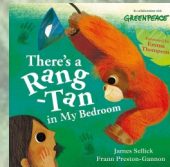

R.E and Christian Values

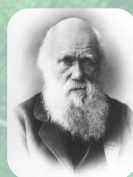
